### *Letter from the Pastor*

The Marvin Chapel ladies held a surprise birthday party for Hilda McPherson, who turned 99 on November 29<sup>th</sup> !!

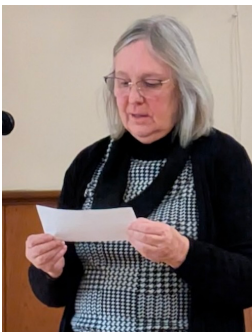
